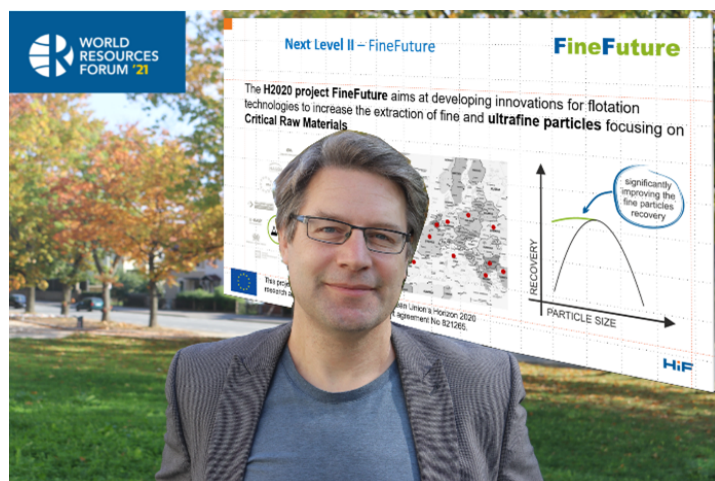

FINE FUTURE PRESENTED AT THE WORLD RESOURCES FORUM 2021

The World Resources Forum 2021 (WRF 2021), originally planned to be held in 2020 in Ghana, was postponed to this year due to the pandemic and organized as a hybrid event with only a few persons in presence in Accra and St. Gallen. The WRF is a non-profit organization located in Switzerland dedicated to the more sustainable and efficient management of resources.

FineFuture's project manager, Stefan Dirlich, had the chance to talk about the utilization of tailings material. He also presented the main goals of FineFuture and how this research can be linked to the topic. Due to the limited time of the session, the talks were scheduled for five minutes only; therefore, Stefan could merely give a rough overview without precise details. Nevertheless, the message that unlocking the potential of (ultra)fine particles from various materials is of great relevance was definitely heard and hopefully understood.

Stefan and his co-authors are now invited to submit an extended abstract for a special issue of the Journal of Circular Economy and Sustainability dedicated to the topic of the WRF: A Green Deal for Sustainable Resources – Extraction, Recovery, Circularity. This special issue published by Springer is supposed to be published in the first half of 2022.
